<u>Poster Delivery Date:</u> Deliver your poster by Monday, September 5th at 9:00 AM to the church social hall for judging. Contestants can summit only one poster. You many use a trifold project board. Attach a copy of the entry form on the top right corner on the back of your poster.

<u>Criteria:</u> Posters are judged on historical accuracy, educational value, creativity, originality, and neatness. Please include your list of sources where you researched for facts. Please include maps, pictures and research documentation.

<u>Poster contest winners</u> are encouraged to attend and be present when winners are announced during the 11:00 AM meeting in the Jerusalem Evangelical Lutheran Church. Posters should remain on display until 3:00 PM at which time they should be picked up. Participants who are unable to attend need to attach a summary statement telling 3 points of interest that they discovered while doing research to create their poster.

Please Note: In case of a tie in any category, the prize will be equally divided between the winners.
